Dnaagdawenmag Binnoojiiyag Child & Family Services is a multi-service Indigenous wellbeing agency. We provide a stable foundation for children, youth, and families, through wraparound services that are culturally based, and family focused.

If there are no current employment opportunities that match your experience and education, we encourage you to submit an application and resume if you would like to be considered for future opportunities at our Agency. All applicants who apply will have their resume added to our talent pool for up to six (6) months.

REQUIREMENTS

Availability Requirements:

- Our office hours are 8:30am - 4:30pm, Monday to Friday, with a one-hour unpaid lunch. However, based on the needs of those we serve, our frontline staff regularly find themselves working outside of these hours, including evenings, weekends, and holidays. Long distance travel is also required.

Knowledge Requirements:

- Knowledge of Indigenous culture and values including awareness of the First Nation, Inuit, and Métis Communities we service.
- A solid understanding of and sensitivity to the experiences of First Nations and Indigenous peoples in Canada, and the impact of the legacy of Residential Schools and the Sixties Scoop upon them is essential.

Mandatory Requirements:

- Must be willing to work flexible hours including weekends, evenings and holidays as required.
- Provide an acceptable Canadian Police Information Centre Check (CPIC) and Vulnerable Sector Screening (VSS).
- Able to provide a safe vehicle for use on the job, an acceptable Driver's Abstract, evidence of a valid Ontario Driver's License and of Personal Liability & Property Damage insurance coverage for at least \$2,000,000.00.

WORKING CONDITIONS

- You will be provided a working location with a hybrid work from home option available.
- Travel within the catchment area is required for direct service to youth/children.



- Traveling with youth/children is required to their home communities and often the reintegration worker will be away for several days.
- Our Agency actively encourages a healthy work life balance and aim to ensure working hours do not exceed 35 hours per week and/or do not need to be conducted during evenings and weekends. However, we recognize that the needs of the children, youth and families do require our services outside of these hours. We have a flexible work policy where we aim to maintain an 8-hour schedule (inclusive of a 1-hour lunch), but there are occasions where such planning is not possible. In this role, you will need to have flexibility in your work schedule.
